AVERAGES

Unclassified competitors (i.e. those who did not enter, or entered but did not fire all the targets in an Aggregate, at an NSRA Meeting in the previous two years) must substantiate their class by submitting EITHER the average of the best 10 of their last 12 scores on British NSRA(BM/89 Series) short range targets OR an average ex 600 on 50 metre international / 50 yard proportional NSRA targets fired up to the time of entry.

Each morning shooting will commence at 08.55, except Saturday which will commence at 10.05, and finish at 13.00. Each afternoon, EXCEPT THE LAST DAY, shooting will commence at 14.10 and finish at 17.10.

During the week firing points will be available for practice and unsquadded competition shooting.

In all squadded competitions every effort will be made to squad all competitors in any one class together. This may not be possible if entries exceed range capacity.
